## **European Show:**

#### **Conditions of Entry**

Open to horses that are registered at birth in a WAHO recognized studbook of a European Country (as defined in Art 3.2 of the Constitution of ECAHO), and

- breeder AND owner (or lessee) must be person/s with European country nationality and a European country citizenship
- breeder AND owner (or lessee) must be company exclusively owned by person/s with European country nationality and a European country citizenship
- breeder AND owner (or lessee) must be Stud farm exclusively owned by person/s with European country nationality and a European country citizenship
- must be Stud farm exclusively owned by a European governments (state studs)
- breeder does not need to be owner of the horse
- no co-ownership is allowed with a person without European Nationality or a company or a studfarm that is owned by a person or entity without European Nationality or a European country citizenship

#### **Entry restrictions**

Title Show or A Show Champion Gold and Silver medal winners are not allowed to take part in a European Show for the rest of that calendar year and the two calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior or junior to a senior category. Gold medal winners in two European Shows in the same year are not allowed to take part in a European Show for the rest of that calendar year.

Geldings that have won Champion Gold or Silver medals at a Title Show or an A Show cannot be shown at European Shows for the rest of that calendar year and one calendar year following.

Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of 600,- Euro and the horse will be disqualified.

## International B-Show:

## **Conditions of Entry**

Open to Horses registered in any WAHO recognized studbook by the closing date of entry.

### Entry restrictions

Title Show or A Show Champion Gold and Silver medal winners are not allowed to take part in a B-Show for the rest of that calendar year and the two calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior or from a junior to a senior category.

Gold medal winners in two B International Shows in the same year are not allowed to take part in a B International Show for the rest of that calender year.

Geldings that have won Champion Gold or Silver medals at a Title Show or an A Show cannot be shown at B Shows for the rest of that calendar year and one calendar year following.

Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of 600,- Euro and the horse will be disqualified.

## European Show and Int. B-Show

#### Judging system Class 3-15 and C-O

Three judges will judge each class independently of each other and without catalogue, giving 1-20 points (half points are allowed) for the following criteria:

- 1.) type
- 2.) head and neck
  - judges give two marks, one for head (2a) and one for neck (2b), divided by 2
- 3.) body
- 4.) legs
- 5.) movement

#### Rules for Ties in Qualifying Places

In the event of a tie in the qualifying places of a class, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for type. If there is still a tie, the higher place will be given to the horse with the most points for movement. If the highest and lowest points are eliminated, only the remaining points for type and movement are considered in the tie break. Failing a decision on either of these, one judge chosen by ballot will name his preference.

#### Rules for Foal classes

Foal classes – recognized by EAHSC (in accordance to Blue Book 2022 – page 4.)

Foals must have a minimum age of four weeks at the date of the show and must be shown with the dam up to 6 month. For proof of age there is a copy of the declaration of birth submitted with the entry form. Orphaned or rejected foals under six month cannot be shown

The use of metal halters and halters with metal chains is forbidden.

The Foals will be judged according the comparative system.

Foals will be led by a halter and stood before the judges. When the ring steward asks for movement, the foal may be turned loose, provided the mare is in the ring. After the individual presentation, it must be caught, and should be led by the halter. Foals which older than 6 month and be shown without the mum need be troted in hand.

Foals will not qualify for any future Title or A-Show. There will be one foal championship for filly and colt foals.

## European Show and Int. B-Show

#### **Rules for Championships**

#### C) Open method

The Gold, Silver and Bronze medal winners will be selected from amongst all the horses which have qualified in their respective classes for each championship.

The first, second and third placed horse of each class will be qualified for the championship.

- 1. All Champions will be judged as follows:
- a.) All the horses qualified for the championship will enter the ring and line up according to the numerical order of their catalogue numbers.
- b.) The horses will be judged individually, standing and trotting.
- c.) Each judge will nominate his choice for gold, silver and bronze medal together at the same time, from amongst all the horses qualified for the championship.

Points will give to the nominated horses as follows:

- A horse nominated by a judge for Gold Medal will receive 4 points.
- A horse nominated by a judge for Silver Medal will receive 2 points.
- A horse nominated by a judge for Bronze Medal will receive 1 point.

The Gold medal will be awarded to the horse with the most votes for Gold Medal Champion. In case of an equal amount of vote for Gold Medal Champion, the Gold Medal will be awarded to the horse with the highest number of championships points.

From the remaining horses:

The Silver medal will be awarded to the horse with highest number of championship points.

The Bronze medal will be awarded to the horse with the 2nd highest number of championship points. In the case of a tie, the Rules for Ties in championships will be followed.

The judges will not discuss the horses.

- 2. A fourth horse will be selected, which will become the Bronze medal winner should one of the three medal winners be disqualified. If this exhibit is not apparent from the voting papers, the judges will be asked to nominate one. This horse will not be announced. In the event that two or more of the medal winners are disqualified, no further substitution will be made.
- 3. All horses that qualify for their respective Championships must take part in the Championship. Unless a certificate from the DC veterinarian is produced, failure to compete will disqualify the horse from the show, with its record of score and class placing being deleted and the horse being disqualified from showing for the period of one year as from the date of the show. In the event of a disqualification, horses placed behind the disqualified horse will move up a place in the class. Should a horse be sent out of the ring by the judges or taken out by the handler for any reason, it will be deemed to have taken part in the championship.

## Rules for Championships

### C) Open method

4. All horses that are awarded a medal in their respective Championships must take part in the Championship prize giving ceremony.

Unless the DC decides otherwise in which case any representative of the horse may accept the medal without the horse being present, absence of the horse or any representative to appear in the prize giving ceremony will disqualify the horse from the show with its record of score in the class and championship placing being deleted and the horse being disqualified from the showing for the period of one year from the date of the show.

In the event of a disqualification, all horses placed behind the disqualified horse will move up one place in the Championship.

During the pricegiving ceremony, the horse may only be on the lead of the designated handler or substitute deemed capable at the discretion of the ringmaster/DC.

#### Rules for Ties in Championships

In the event of a tie in the championship, the higher place will be given to the horse with the highest total points in the qualifying classes. If the highest and lowest points are eliminated, only the remaining points for total, type and movement are considered in the tie break. If there is still a tie, the rules for ties in qualifying places will be applied.

#### **Basic Rules**

The rules set down in the Blue Book 2022 of the EAHSC apply in every aspect. In case of doubt or differing opinions, the original English version applies.

Apart from that, the following ECAHO rules apply:

- Rules for Conduct of Shows Rules for Ties in Qualifying Places Rules for Championships
- Rules for Disciplinary Committees Rules for Medication Control
- 1) The ECAHO show rules and regulations apply in their entirety.
- 2) On submitting the entry forms, all exhibitors, their agents, and associates agree to accept these regulations and to follow the organizer's instructions
- 3) All exhibitors will accept the judges decisions, which are limited to this show and based on the judging system laid down in the regulations.
- 4) The judges' decisions are final and will not be contested. The judges are not liable for any consequences resulting from their decisions.
- 5) All horses must be free of contagious diseases and come from a non-infected stable.
- 6) They must be effectively vaccinated against equine influenza (see ECAHO Blue Book 2022 IV. Addendum) It is strongly advised to vaccinate against virus abort.
  - The equine passport must be shown to the DCs. In case of a missing vaccination pass, or any suspicion of contagious disease, the organizer may have the horse examined by a veterinarian at the owner's costs. The organizer is entitled to have the horse quarantined according the veterinarian's decision. ECAHO Rules for Medication Control (see Blue Book 2022 page 47) will apply.
- 7) The organizer accepts no responsibility for accidents, illnesses, theft, fire, or any kind of damage, whether to people or to animals and objects, in particular, no third party liability for any damages. The owners of all horses or other animals at the show ground must have legal liability. Everyone is personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by himself, his associates etc., or his horses.
- 8) Start numbers and catalogues will be given out at the show office.
- 9) The horse is not allowed to start at the show if the entry and box fee is not payed when the show starts.
- 9) There will be no compensation for transportation costs.
- 10) One assistant handler with a whip from the DC is allowed in the ring for the individual presentation.
