Ecaho European Show Rules

**Entries closing date: May 29th 2025*

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Open to horses that are registered at birth in a WAHO recognised studbook of a European Country (as defined in Art. 3.2 of the Constitution of ECAHO),

- Breeder and owner (or lessee) must be person(s) with a European Passport,
- Breeder and owner (or lessee) must be a company exclusively owned by person(s) with a European Passport,
- Breeder and owner (or lessee) must be a Stud farm exclusively owned by person(s) with a European passport,
- Breeder and owner (or lessee) must be a Stud farm exclusively owned by a European country government (state stud),
- Owner does not need to be breeder of the horse,
- No co-ownership is allowed with a person without a European country nationality,
- Studbook registration of ownership or lease between a non-European person or Breeding entity and a European person or Breeding entity, fulfilling the conditions mentioned above, must be at least 6 months before the date of the show,
- Anybody entering a horse not fulfilling the entry conditions will be liable to a fine of €600 and the horse will be disqualified.

ADDITIONAL RESTRICTION OF ENTRIES:

- Horses must be owned by a "natural" European citizen (not legal),
- Partnership is allowed if all parties are European citizens,
- No horses will be allowed to participate in both shows,

- "World Championship, Title show, A Show or GCAT Show Champion Gold, Silver and Bronze medal winners are not allowed to take part in a Breeders' show for the rest of that calendar year and the two calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior, OR from junior to a senior category",
- Gold Medal winners in 2 European Shows in the same year are not allowed to take part in a European Show for the rest of that Calendar year,
- "Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of €600 and the horse will be disqualified".
- Classes will be as following:

Yearling fillies

2 years old fillies

3 years old fillies

Yearling colts

2 years old colts

3 years old colts

4-6 years old mares

7 years old and above mares

4-6 years old stallions

7 years old and above stallions

JUDGING SYSTEM

Système de jugement

- o 4 judges will judge independently of each other.
4 juges, jugeront indépendamment les uns des autres.
- o Points will be given from 1 to 20 (half points allowed) for the following criteria:

Type
Head and Neck (judged together – *jugés ensemble*)
Body
Legs
Movement

CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 3 first of each class will be qualified for the championships if more than 4 horses are entered in the catalogue.

Les 3 premiers de chaque classe seront qualifiés pour les championnats si plus de 4 chevaux sont engagés dans le catalogue.

The championships will be judged as Open championship:

- The Gold Medal will be awarded to the horse with the most votes for Gold Medal Champion.
- The Silver Medal will be awarded to the horse with the highest number of championship points.
- The Bronze Medal will be awarded to the horse with the 2nd highest number of Championship points.
- A fourth horse will be selected, which will become the Bronze Medal winner should one of the 3 medal winners be disqualified.
