



Ecaho International B Show Rules

**Entries closing date: May 26th 2026*

ENTRIES RESTRICTIONS **Restrictions d'engagements**

- World Championship, Title Show, A Show or GCAT Show Champion Gold and Silver winners are not allowed to take part of a B show for the rest of that calendar year and the 2 calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior, from junior to a senior category.
- Gold medal winners in two B International Shows in the same year are not allowed to take part in a B International Show for the rest of that calendar year.
- Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of € 600 and the horse will be disqualified.

QUALIFYING CLASSES

Classes qualificatives

The International "B" Show is scheduled to start on Saturday afternoon. The championships will be held on Sunday. (Timing will be sent upon the closing of entries)

- Classes will be as following:

Yearling females A	Femelles de 1 an A
Yearling females B	Femelles de 1 an B
If enough yearlings are entered	Si assez de pouliches de 1 an sont engagées
2 years old females	Femelles de 2 ans
3 years old females	Femelles de 3 ans
4-6 years old females	Femelles de 4 à 6 ans
7 years old and above females	Femelles de 7 ans et plus
Yearling males A	Mâles de 1 an A
Yearling males B	Mâles de 1 an B
If enough yearlings are entered	Si assez de poulains de 1 an sont engagés
2 years old males	Mâles de 2 ans
3 years old males	Mâles de 3 ans
4-6 years old males	Mâles de 4 à 6 ans
7 years old and above males	Mâles de 7 ans et plus

*Classes division may vary depending on the number of horses per category.

JUDGING SYSTEM

Système de jugement

- 4 judges will judge independently of each other in a rotation system.
4 juges, jugeront indépendamment les uns des autres dans un système de rotation.
- Points will be given from 1 to 20 (half points allowed) for the following criteria:
Les points seront donnés entre 1 et 20 (demi-point autorisé) pour les critères suivants :
 - Type
 - Head and Neck (judged together – *jugés ensemble*)
 - Body
 - Legs
 - Movement

CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 3 first of each class will be qualified for the championships if more than 4 horses are entered in the catalogue.

Les 3 premiers de chaque classe seront qualifiés pour les championnats si plus de 4 chevaux sont engagés dans le catalogue.

The championships will be judged as Open championship:

- The Gold Medal will be awarded to the horse with the most votes for Gold Medal Champion.
- The Silver Medal will be awarded to the horse with the highest number of championship points.
- The Bronze Medal will be awarded to the horse with the 2nd highest number of Championship points.
- A fourth horse will be selected, which will become the Bronze Medal winner should one of the 3 medal winners be disqualified.

In addition to the International Champions, we will reward the top 3 best European horses in the classes (from each category) 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places during the championships.
